The Complex Management Unit (CMU) is a 20 bed subacute unit where patients with complex psychosocial and functional needs are admitted while they await discharge planning. The unit is supported by rehabilitation physician and a geriatrician. The unit offers opportunities to provide ongoing person-centred care to long stay patients.
