Access Team

The Child and Youth Mental Health Access Team provides a community-based assessment and acute care service for children and young people aged 0-18 years and their families in the Gold Coast region who have complex mental health needs.

The Child & Youth Mental Health Service (CYMHS) Access Team provides a telephone triage service for all new referrals received via telephone, fax, email or through the local Emergency Departments.

Following initial contact, a child/young person and their family may be offered an appointment for an initial assessment to gather more information and/or offer support during a crisis. They may receive information and guidance on how to access other services in the community which will better suit their needs or be referred through to one of our continuing care teams or specialty services.

Referrals to the CYMHS Access Team can be made by self, family member, doctor, school or other professional.

Treating Team

- Psychiatrists
- Nurses
- Allied Health Professionals (Psychology, Social Work, Occupational Therapy, Mental Health Clinician)
- Carer Peer Workers
