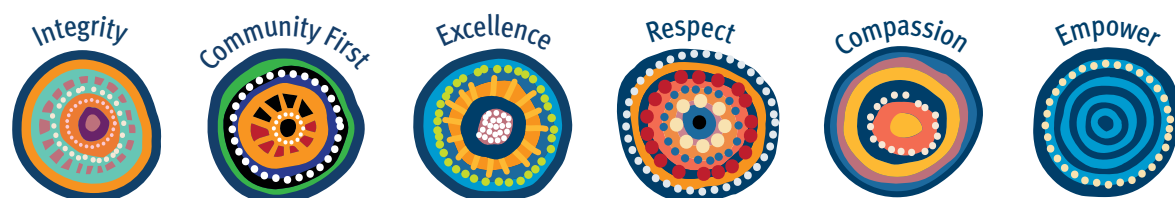
Magnet recognition

Gold Coast Hospital and Health Service is committed to its six guiding principles. These principles are at the core of all positions and articulate the behaviours that are required when working within the Health Service:



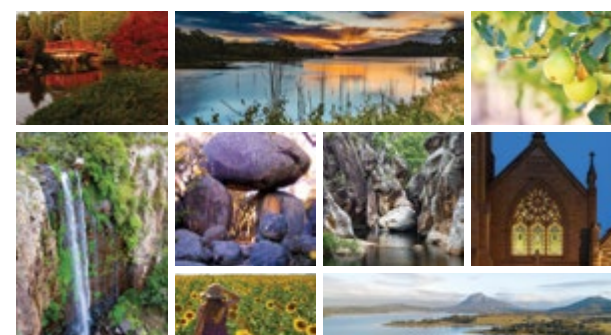
Whilst we implement our strategic objectives to be recognised as a centre of excellence for world class health care, our values provide the framework to focus our individual behaviours and performance outcomes.
