Ways to help me say... 'g'



1. Show me (visual cues)

- Help me look in a mirror so I can see my tongue position
- You model the sound by repeating lots of words that contain the 'g' sound

2. Tell me these tips (verbal cues)

- "Put the back of your tongue at the back of your mouth"
- "Make the sound come from the back of your mouth."
- "Put the front of your tongue down" (you might need to hold the front of my tongue down with my finger)
- "Open your mouth wide!"
- "Make it loud!"

3. Help me say my sound in:

- Isolation
- Syllables (e.g. gar, goo, og)
- Beginning of words (e.g. game, goal)
- Ends of words (e.g. bag, leg, egg)
- Phrases (e.g. I see a bag)

Please give me lots of **praise**.
e.g. "That was a nice 'g' sound!
Your tongue was back!"
You can also praise me for good
sitting/listening/looking/trying
e.g. "Good trying"

"I'm getting better at saying my 'g' sound each time we practice together!"
