

Ways to help me say... 'j'



1. Show me (visual cues)

- Help me look in a mirror so I can see my round lips
- You model the sound by repeating lots of words that contain the 'j' sound

2. Tell me these tips (verbal cues)

- "Push your lips forward."
- "Make it a quick sound."
- "make it a loud sound."

3. Help me say my sound in:

- Isolation
- Syllables (e.g. jee, jar, orj, ooj)
- Beginning of words (e.g. jump, jam)
- End of words (e.g. bridge, cage)
- Phrases (e.g. I can jump)

Please give me lots of **praise**.
e.g. "That was a nice 'j' sound!"

You can also praise me for good sitting/listening/looking/trying e.g. "Good trying"

"I'm getting better at saying my 'j' sound each time we practice together!"
