The Better Cardiac Care team is passionate about providing education to staff, patients and families.

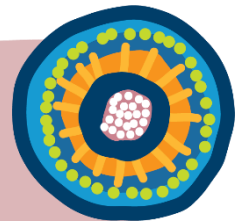
- Improve knowledge and awareness about all types of heart health.
