Gold Coast Health offers a Transition to Specialty Framework which provides nurses with opportunities to upskill in a specialty area.

Transition to Specialty requires commitment to undertake formal education covering the theoretical knowledge and skills required to practice in that specialty area. The program is supported by the relevant specialty education team. Once completed, this will attract advanced standing at tertiary level to enable participants to work towards a post graduate qualification.

Transition to Specialty is offered as a 12-month temporary contract within the specialty area.
