 - Dementia care principles

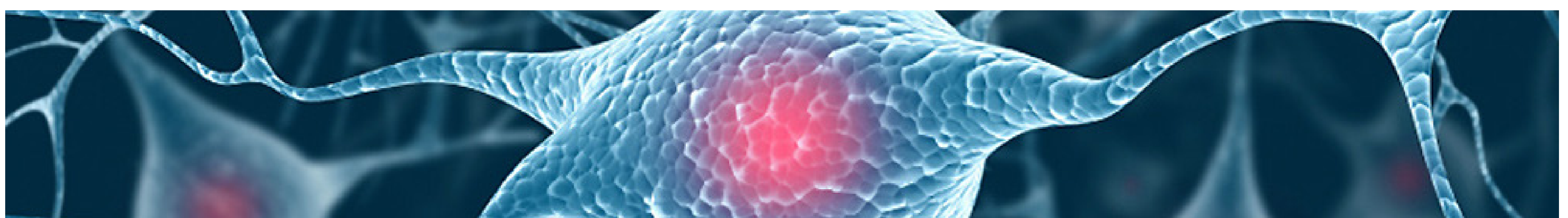
