The Medical Decision Unit (MDU) and the Medical Assessment Unit (MAU) are both 28 bed units providing a 24 hour, 7 day a week service with a maximum stay length of stay of 48 hours. MDU / MAU assess and admit adult medical patients, improving patient flow through the GCHHS health service by providing rapid assessment and diverting patients from the emergency department. Patients are also accepted via outpatients and other hospitals.
