The renal ward, C3 West, is a 24 bed inpatient unit caring for a range of complex acute and chronic renal conditions, providing pre-dialysis care, education and community support. We manage medical and surgical clients who have pre-existing kidney conditions and we also provide high quality, patient focused care to those with end stage kidney disease, requiring haemodialysis or peritoneal dialysis, post-transplant care or kidney supportive care. We also provide acute dialysis to inpatients and emergency presentations as required.
